

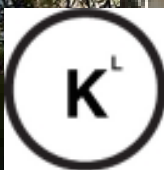

First round: Choice from Baroque or Classical repertoire (20 minutes)
Second round (semi-finals): Choice from Romantic repertoire (20 minutes)
Finale: Choice of repertoire from all periods (30 minutes)

Categories

Category I: Strings, piano, or voice
Category II: winds (including saxophone), with or without piano accompaniment; and percussion.

Prizes

First Prize: 2000 Euro, plus recital
Second Prize: 1000 Euro
Third Prize: 500 Euro
